Sarah's Home/Daniel Academy

At our June 5th meeting Jillian Winters was our guest speaker talking about Sarah's Home and Daniel Academy.

At Sarah's Home, we provide a sanctuary for teenage girls who are survivors of sex trafficking as they reclaim the life God created them to have.

Our faith-based program is designed to walk each girl through the process of coming to terms with their pain and empowering them in their healing. We equip them and their support network with enough tools to continue their healing journey.

Our house is truly a home where survivors have the space to begin their lifelong healing journey. We serve teen age girls from all over the United States, ages 12 to 17. Our relationships with our community, FBI agents, courts, local law enforcement and guardian ad litems have connected us with these survivors and continue to align with us in the fight against sex trafficking.

Daniel Academy is in the process of being build and will house boys age 12 to 17, who have also experienced sex trafficking.

Our New Partnership with the Castle Pines Satellite Rotary Club

Our speakers at the June 19th meeting were Lin Milkas and Steve Baroch from the CP Satellite Rotary Club. There was a discussion about their March for Mental Health Initiative. They are supporting a program that will train pediatricians, primary care physicians, and physician assistants who treat youth ages 6-16. They would be trained in a program created by Boston Children's Hospital on how to screen for behavioral health concerns. Behavioral health concerns that are identified sooner means that treatment or connection to other resources and supports can start sooner, with the goal of improving student mental wellness and outcomes.

They are planning a community Conversation between citizens of Castle Rock and a panel of experts on mental health. It is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, September, 25th from 6:30 to 8:30 pm. Location and date to be confirmed at a later date.

Castle Rock Kiwanis is very interested in partnering with the Rotary on this project as teen suicide is something our club feels needs to be addressed.
