Skilled Nursing Homes are regulated and reimbursed by the federal government. Our profession is currently the most regulated industry in the nation; more than nuclear waste disposal; more than banks; more than schools; more than hospitals.

On the national level, our regulations come from both the Presidential Administration (Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services which falls under Health and Human Servies) as well as Congress (Senate and House of Representatives). Politics are definitely involved in the oversight and reimbursement of skilled nursing facilities. In addition, each state has it's own set of regulations and reimbursement rules with Medicaid funding for the communities with the licensure of skilled nursing facility.

As a result, advocacy for the care of our elders is imperative. When new legislation or regulations are proposed, which occurs with frequency for our sector, our elected officials might not understand the impact or unintended consequences of the proposal. As such, it is imperative that we are aware of the proposed changes and share with our representatives and administrative offices how the proposed changes would impact our ability to care for our elders.

The demographics are clearly showing an increase in our aging population, and at the same time birthrates have declined. It is my hope and aspiration that we as a society can find a way to collaboratively work together to serve our elders and support those who admirably choose to serve our elders.
