We look forward to having you join us!!



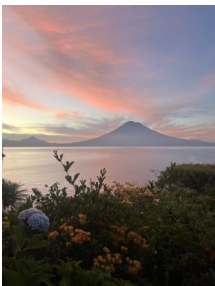
Sarah Schumann

I have traveled to India 7 times, where I have connected with the monks of Sera Monastery and worked on service projects for the Tibetan in exile nursing homes. To date, we have paid the salaries of staff, built a water purification system, a new kitchen, solar powered lights, and an emergency solar battery backup. The current project we are working on is repairs for the tile roofing.

I visited 4 nursing homes during my visit. In addition, we traveled throughout the Himalaya Mountain region, several Tibetan in exile settlements, and Southern India.

In Guatemala, we traveled to: Lake Atitlan, Guatemala and Tikal. I traveled with my community of yoga teachers and had a wonderful time.
