Wildlife Crossings in Douglas County

Our speaker February 19th was Chuck Attardo, Environmental Manager for CDOT. Members were interested in the new Wildlife Crossings that have been put up in Douglas County.

There have been \$80 million dollars in wildlife collisions each year. That is 7000 collisions each year. And CDOT estimates that this is an underreported number and that the amount is much larger than reported. There are 39 acres protected in the South Gap Mitigation systems. Three new underpasses were reconstructed and one new over pass has been built. The largest problem was to figure out how to build the underpasses without major road construction. The used a cost benefit related system with cameras snapping photos of wildlife using the underpasses for information.

By year three, 99% of wildlife were using these underpasses. The rate of reduction to vehicle accidents is estimated at 91%. And there have been a 10% reduction in travel delays.

The overpass above I25 has allowed the Elk population to populate both sides of the highway.

They are now working on the problems of maintenance as animals make holes in the fencing.

We will have Chuck back to talk about the other projects being addressed in Douglas County.
